Southwest Region- Quarterly Report April to June 2015

Highlights:

The highlight of this quarter was the success of the Southwest Regions children summer programming. Summers traditionally have been slow for the region, so it was impressive to see the strong response to this year's topics. Ms. Timo built upon previous youth programs success, and she developed a directed flyer in January to advertise for the summer. Between June and August, staff had visited with 17 libraries and other youth programming venues. Over 600 children and their caregivers were reached this summer.

Public Outreach

- Delivered 3 lectures at local educational and historical venues; over 130 people attended.
- Completed 9 youth activities for 361 participants at regional libraries.

Assistance to Local Governments

- All of the library programs summarized in the "Public Outreach" of this report were done in collaboration with local governmental organizations.
- We continued planning with Collier County government for the proposed Stewardship Workshop.

Administrative Duties

- Participated in staff meetings at SW and SE FPAN offices.
